The Asia-Pacific Regional Committee of the International Brain Research Organisation (APRC-IBRO) sets aside a limited amount of money each year to support Members in the region to attend Local or International Scientific Meetings.

Funds will be awarded to applicants undertaking a research higher degree (Masters or PhD), or who are no more than 5 years from graduation with a research Masters or PhD. The main criteria by which applications will be judged will be number and quality of publications and the quality of the conference to which the trip is to be made.

Submissions will be considered four times a year at the following deadlines (30 Jan, 30 Apr, 30 July, 30 Oct). All reports from Supervisor or Head of Department and referee must also be received by these dates, and it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that this occurs. APRC-IBRO takes no responsibility for the late receipt of any material. Applications will be decided upon over the subsequent 4 weeks.

Payments will not be made in advance, but on receipt of **original invoices** (Fares/meals/accommodation etc) and certification by email correspondence from the Supervisor/Head of Department of attendance.

Evidence of registration, and attendance, at the meeting (Hotel receipt/Boarding passes etc are acceptable) must be provided. All documentation will remain the property of APRC-IBRO and will not be returned. Applicants who wish to have copies of any material should do so prior to sending them to APRC-IBRO.
